- I/We undertake to pay to all rentals, fees and any additional/incidental expenses incurred by the student and when they become due and payable. We also understand that there is a minimum stay of twelve months and renewable thereafter. (*Prices are based on a 52 week/lyr (minimum) lease agreement.*)
- Under 18 students must adhere to the rules set up and rolled out by their education providers.
- I/We understand that the Residence will be in accordance with a Residential Tenancy Agreement. This agreement is in the required form set out in the Residential Tenancies Regulations (Victoria).
- I/We fully understand and agree that the student will be allowed to walk, ride a bike, travel by private vehicle and/or on public transport to any area unless specific written instructions are received by ASA from us, the parent/s or guardian, stating otherwise. We understand that ASA will exercise all due care and supervision to ensure the safety of the student and we will not hold ASA or its management liable or responsible for any negligence/injuries/accidents howsoever caused.
- I/We fully understand and undertake to ensure that the student shall have adequate medical, dental and ambulance insurance covers during her residence at ASA. We hereby consent to any medical treatment deemed necessary at any time to be given to the student. We undertake to pay all medical expenses related to the student.
- I/We must take reasonable care to avoid damaging the premises.
- I/We shall keep the premises in a reasonable clean condition during the period of Agreement
- I/We shall not use or allow the premises to be used in such a manner as to cause a nuisance or cause an interference with the reasonable peace, comfort or privacy of any occupier of neighbouring premises.
- I/We are aware that we have a "serious water shortage problem in Melbourne" and students must not take this warning lightly when they are living in Melbourne.
- I/We understand that any activity/ies undertaken by the student that is/are deemed illegal under the laws of Australia may be reported to the Australian Police as appropriate. I/We fully understand and undertake that we will not hold its management in any way responsible in the event the student undertakes such illegal activities or causes loss or damage to themselves or others by breaching the Rules and Regulations at ASA. I/We will indemnify

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ASA for any third party claims against it arising from such breaches or any acts of negligence, recklessness or wilful damage by the student generally.

- I/We hereby confirm we are the true parents, legal guardian and legal fee payer for the student and that all information provided herein is, to the best of our knowledge, accurate and true. I/we shall not in any way hold management responsible for any untoward incidents/accidents in relation to the student as a result of wrongful information provided herein by me/us.

- At the end of the final term, students must remove all of their belongings from their rooms. There are facilities at ASA to store their gear during vacations for the students that are returning.

- I/We fully understand that three warnings (verbal / written) will be given when a student misbehaves excessively to the detriment of the accommodation. If the "unacceptable behaviour" continues, ASA will enforce the exit procedures that are currently in place, in the Rules and Regulations rule book at ASA.
- I/We fully understand that one month's advance notice will be given if there are any changes made to fee structure after the minimum 12 month term of a student's stay.
- Repeated offences by a resident could constitute grounds for early termination of their License to Occupy, however, they will still be held responsible for Accommodation Fees until the room is re-let.
